INTRODUCTION

Baby Memorial Hospital Ltd., Kozhikode, established in the year 1987, is a 600 bed Super Specialty Tertiary care referral hospital. 1. B.Sc. NURSING COURSE

Duration : Four years

No of Seats : 90

Eligibility for Admission:- Candidates seeking admission for B.Sc. Nursing course should fulfill the following:

- Candidates who have passed higher secondary examinations of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Govt. of Kerala or equivalent as recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology put together are eligible for admission.

- Applicant should have completed 17 years of age on the **31st December 2026**.
For the proof of age, self attested copy of relevant page of School Record such as SSLC/ CBSE/ ICSE certificate or copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application form.

DURATION

The duration of the course shall be Four Academic Years from the date of joining of the course.
The maximum period to complete the course is Eight Years.

2. POST BASIC B.Sc. NURSING COURSE

Duration : Two years
No. of Seats : 20

Eligibility for Admission:- Candidates seeking admission for Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course should fulfill the following:

- Successful completion of General Nursing and Midwifery course recognized by INC and have valid registration with any State Nursing Council in India.
- At the time of joining they should submit the registration with Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council, if not submitted earlier.
- Candidates should have passed higher secondary examinations of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Govt. of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional.

DURATION

The duration of the course shall be Two Academic Years from the date of joining of the course.
The maximum period to complete the course is Four Years.

3. M.Sc. NURSING PROGRAMME

Duration : Two years
No. of Seats : 20

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates seeking admission for M.Sc. Nursing should fulfill the following.
- Successful completion of Four Year B.Sc. Nursing Degree course / Regular Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree of 2 years conducted by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) or from any other university recognized by the KUHS as equivalent.

- a) B.Sc. Nursing candidates should have One Year experience / Internship after Registration with Nursing Council.
- b) Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing qualified candidates shall have one year experience prior to or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing and registration in the respective State Nursing Council.
- Candidates registered with other state Councils should obtain registration from Kerala Nurses' and Midwives' Council before joining the course.
- Candidate shall be Medically fit.
- The criteria for selection and method of admission to Merit / Management seats is governed by the Rules and Regulations prescribed by the Govt. of Kerala/Institution/ University and INC

DURATION

The duration of the course shall be Two Academic Years from the date of joining of the course.

The maximum period to complete the course is Four Years.

- a) Application for admission and prospectus are available only through online mode, visit

- b) The payment of application fee is Rs.1000/-only through online mode. After filling up all necessary information and uploading details of marks the candidates can “submit” fee for application in online mode. Once submission of application and payment of fee is successful, candidate will receive an electronically generated receipt to his/her registered email. After submission of application in online mode candidates shall take a printout of the same, which shall be submitted to the College of Nursing office with copy of all supporting documents.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

The printout of application with enclosures shall be submitted to the Principal, Baby Memorial College of Nursing, Kozhikode - 673 016, on or before the last date shown in admission notification. Self attested copies of the following certificates shall be enclosed with the application form as shown below for each course.

*** Applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from the universities/ boards outside Kerala shall produce the eligibility certificate from KUHS and Migration certificate from the universities/ boards concerned.**

b) Upload Photo

Passport size photographs shall be uploaded during online submission of application. Photographs shall be below 50 KB in jpg/ jpeg/ png format.

c) Additional documents to be attached with Application Form for NRI Quota Seats in B.Sc. Nursing.

1. A candidate who apply for the NRI seat should submit the Passport copy and Visa/Green Card/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
2. The Visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the Medical and Allied courses.
3. In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/ Consulate authorities.
4. The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O (Ms) No.243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014
5. However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.
6. The candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs.200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is **dependent of the sponsor*** and the all expenses i.e tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor.
7. All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI Status/ Non Creamy Layer/

Minority etc shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

**** An applicant, who depends upon his/her Father/ Mother/ Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/ Husband/ Wife/ Brothers and Sisters (Inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/ Half Brother/ Half Sister/ Adopted Father or Adopted Mother working abroad."***

Preparation of merit list

a) **B.Sc.Nursing :-** Marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology in **Higher Secondary Examination*** will be considered for preparation of merit list. If there is a tie, marks of Biology will be taken, followed by Physics and Chemistry. If all these are equal Date of Birth of candidate will be considered, ie. with person of higher age getting preference over the younger.

*** CBSE/ ICSE Senior Secondary Examination marks will be equated with Higher Secondary marks of Kerala syllabus by approved normalisation process.**

b) **M.Sc. Nursing & Post Basic B.Sc.Nursing :-** Marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for preparation of merit list. If there is a tie, Date of Birth of candidate will be considered ie. person of higher age getting preference over the younger.

IMPORTANT:

1. The tentative schedule of admission is available on website.
2. Candidates are advised to visit website for all notifications/ information and also to get updated on any change or modification in admission schedule, ***No personal intimation will be send in this regard.***
3. Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the applications for the same course submitted subsequent to the first application.
4. Candidate who do not take admission on the date prescribed in allotment memo.

COURSE FEE*

The fee structure shown below was fixed by Govt/Fee Regulatory Committee for the previous year. Any revision in the fee structure ordered by the competent authorities for the current academic year (2026-27) will have to be paid by the candidate.

Annual fee for all courses are payable at the beginning of academic year during each year of the course.

Caution Deposit is refundable after the completion of course on submission of Non Liability Certificate (NLC).

DISCONTINUATION : Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing college before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the First year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the college midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court”.

EXAMINATION:** Regular University Examination are conducted at the end of each term and supplementary examination as notified by University. Examination fees shall be remitted by the candidate as stipulated by the University from time to time.

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING EXAMINATION

No candidate shall be admitted to any part of the examinations unless he/ she has a minimum of 80% or above attendance of classes, as well as practicals in each subjects separately.

Those candidates who do not have the minimum class average mark (internal assessment) of 50% shall not be allowed to appear for the University examinations in any subject of that period.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

College:

1. Students shall strictly observe professional conduct and high standards of discipline.

4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College and Hostel. If any incident of ragging occurs, strict action will be taken as per the latest direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
5. Use of mobile phone by the students is strictly prohibited in class, clinics and during working hours. If found in use, it will be confiscated.
6. Use of drugs / smoking / alcoholism etc are strictly prohibited in class / compound / clinics / hostel. Any violation lead to dismissal from the College.
7. Any type of indisciplinary behaviour (whistling, passing comments, exhibiting posters, spreading rumours, shouting etc) towards teachers, other students or staff will not be tolerated and will be subjected to major disciplinary actions.
8. Any change in the contact address / telephone number should be informed to the College immediately. College will not be responsible for any delay /non receipt of information /communication due to the change in address.
9. The institution shall not be liable in the delay / loss in communication owing to failure of postal / courier service.
10. Each student should report for class / clinics in the specified time. Late comers will not be allowed to attend class / clinics.
11. Students should inform class co-ordinator / concerned teacher about any inability to attend classes and should submit the leave letter in time. Absenteeism from class / clinics without prior information will be marked as double absence along with other disciplinary actions.
12. Assignments / projects should be submitted in time as prescribed by the teacher and delay will be a reason for reduction of internal marks.

UNIFORM

Students are to follow dress code strictly in class and clinical area as specified by the institution.

HOSTEL

Hostel facility is available only for the women students. All the inmates shall strictly follow the hostel rules and regulations.
